**Who?** Open (and free of charge) to homeless individuals  
and families.

Birth certificates are often needed to receive medical assistance, housing and other public benefits, to obtain a Pennsylvania driver's or non-driver's license, for access to many public buildings, for general identification and many other purposes.

Homeless individuals who attend this free clinic will meet with an advocate who will request birth certificates for them and their minor children free of charge.

### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

- **HAP will only request one birth certificate within a one year period.**
- **Birth certificates requested at this clinic may not be back before June, 2018. PA current processing time is 23 weeks (July, 2018).**
- **In some cases, the following states may reject requests without photo ID: Michigan and Puerto Rico**  
-HAP is currently trying to work through the issues.
- **HAP does not help individuals obtain PENNDOT identification.**
